**SNIPPETS FROM THE YEAR BOOK OF PRAYER:** In January, 2010, The Presbytery of New York City worshipped at the Annual Service of Remembrance for the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Tensions exposed by historic patterns of injustice and the temptation of forgetting were acknowledged and reconciliation was celebrated. Presbyterians in New York City are feeding the poor; sheltering the homeless; advocating for economic justice and for comprehensive immigration reform; accompanying people on their journeys home from incarceration; visiting them in prison; acting to change prison policies; responding to HIV and AIDS; reaching out to youth; providing legal services to immigrants; supporting through speakers bureaus and arts programs the voices of those often rendered silent; collaborating with community partners, of faith and otherwise, and creating relationships across the world.
