Skeet's Pantry Needs Some Food! With many thanks to all our friends in the congregation who have been so generous, we're asking again for some food for our pantry. Snippets from the Year Book of Prayer: We do not hear much about Niger but are dismayed to learn that in that country life expectancy is around 50 years. Twenty percent of all children die before their fifth birthday. One in seven women dies in childbirth or from related complications. There is one physician for every 53,000 people--a total of about 325 doctors in this country of 17 million inhabitants. As a result the Presbyterian Church(U.S.A.) partner in Niger, the Evangelical Church in the Republic of Niger is dedicating its scarce resources to building up the health ministry of the church to serve both its members and the country as a whole. The church plans to build a clinic in the capital from which it will reach out to poorer and rural parts of the country where the need for health care is even greater.
