Skeet's Pantry Needs Some Food! With many thanks to all our friends in the congregation who have been so generous, we're asking again for some food for our pantry. Specifically, we need PASTA, RICE and CEREAL. Any kind, any size (but think "family size" if possible) will be very welcome. So thanks again for always being there when we need your help!

Snippets from the Year Book of Prayer: Located in a low-income neighborhood, Third Church in Springfield, IL, found a way to reach out to the surrounding community by building a children's library. The church had the space for a library but lacked books and furniture. But soon after making the decision to establish a library, the congregation received a large donation of furniture, including tables, chairs, and bookshelves. Local public libraries were in the process of closing and offered books at a discount. Now the

library collection consists of close to 10,000 books and new donations are added daily. These books are free of charge for the children. The congregation has received a grant from the Presbytery Mission Initiative Fund and that money was used to purchase IPADS and touch-screen computers. In addition to the book collection, the library hosts programs on Saturdays, thus filling a real need for literacy, and a safe place for neighborhood children.
