## MISSION, SERVICE & GRANTS

• **Snippets from the Year Book of Prayer:** The Rev. Kevin Finch realized that something should be done to care for those working in the restaurant and hospitality industry because (1) food service workers are the largest employment group in the nation; (2) they are incredibly isolated-most working when the rest of us are not and (3) they face intense stress and have the highest rates of drug and alcohol abuse in the nation. In addition, the industry is the catch basin for the most vulnerable in our culture; at-risk teens, single parents, minorities, new immigrants, and ex-felons trying to put their lives back together. As a result, The Rev. Finch organized what he calls Big Table, a place where workers can share meals around an actual big table, and care without condition. Big Table has become a stunning way of reaching those in an industry full of people alienated from church and angry at a God they mistakenly believe offers only conditional grace.
