MISSION, SERVICE & GRANTS

- **TASK Mission:** Due to van driver schedule changes, we are in need of additional van driver(s) to take volunteers to the Trenton Area Soup Kitchen (TASK) the first Thursday of each month to serve a meal. - **Snippets from the Year Book of Prayer:** Life in Alaska is very different from life here in New Jersey! Nine of the 23 congregations in the Presbytery of Yukon in Alaska are located in small villages off the road system. Specialized medical care and other important services are available only in the larger hub communities, and the required air travel is expensive. It is, therefore, not at all unusual for a church in Barrow or Fairbanks to receive an emergency call from one of the villages. The pastors, deacons, and elders stand ready to provide care in the name of Jesus Christ on behalf of their home congregations back in the villages.

Anchorage is the largest service providing community in the state and, as a result, its Presbyterian congregations have responded by training three commissioned ruling elders to join in this ministry. These persons provide a connection for patients far from home. These leaders offer prayer and comfort and sometimes also transportation to visit relatives or run errands while in the city.
