**MISSION, SERVICE & GRANTS**

**Snippets from the Year Book of Prayer:** A small church in Dyersburg, TN, determined that, though small, it could do something! So, More Than a Meal (MTaM) was begun. And now six hearty meals with traditional feasts at holiday time are served yearly. People from Dyersburg receive a hot meal, some good conversation and prayer, along with help applying for food stamps, processing a job application, obtaining state photo IDs, driver's licenses, birth certificates, and/or other important documents. The whole congregation gets involved in serving this multicultural group of 75-100 people. A happy outgrowth is that a larger Dyersburg church saw in the paper that this small church had started MTA M and now they are serving, too.
