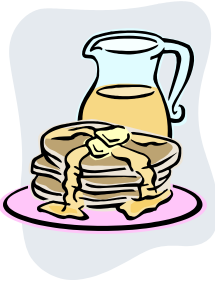

ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING: As we celebrate and rejoice in Easter, let us keep in mind our giving opportunity when we make our contribution to ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING next Sunday. I want to mention a particular service given by the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance which is one of the recipients of ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING. Typhoon Haiyan in the Philippines in November 2013 was one of the strongest storms recorded at landfall. Millions of people were displaced and more than 6,000 died. Early efforts supported by PDA included providing immediate assistance of emergency food, plastic sheeting, water and sanitation repair, programs of cash for work, shelter assistance and blankets for more than 200,000 persons.

But the help of Presbyterian Disaster Assistance did not stop there because its priorities shifted toward the longer-term challenges of helping to rebuild people's lives to include permanent housing, schools, water and sanitation facilities and the restoration of fishing and agricultural livelihoods. It is obvious that your gifts to ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING help provide both immediate and long term responses to people in need.
