## **MISSION, SERVICE & GRANTS**

---

**From the Mission Yearbook:** Available and adequate education is not the only problem in the Dominican Republic of the Congo. There, 48 women are raped every hour. This harsh reality is a result of decades of war during which internal and external militia invade and compete for the country's precious mineral resources. Although Congo is arguably the richest country in Africa, it ranks among the poorest countries on the continent. Our partner, the Church of Christ in Congo offers a healing place for injured and ostracized women. These women receive medical attention and surgery, spiritual healing and recovery, and safety as they become reintegrated into daily life. And a most touching part of the story is that many of the women who have lost their children to war, are adopting other children orphaned by the same atrocities. If it weren't for the church that took on the critical task of speaking the unspeakable, things would be much worse for survivors.
