- L: We are a people of hope. Last Sunday the frail light of a single candle dared to pierce through the darkness of desolation and sin.
- P: Hope lives in us and will abide with us.**
- L: Today we will light the candle of peace.
- P: This light, too, must brave the great darkness.**
- L: In an age when people seldom find peace within themselves, and when all the earth knows the sorrow of war, we light a fire called peace.
- P: Peace that is not merely the absence of war and conflict, but peace that is the fullness of blessing for all - that is the peace for which we dare to hope.**
- L: Christ comes to bring peace to those who have been separated from God and one another.
- P: In the name of that Child born so long ago, we light the candles of peace and hope.**

As you know CPNS uses Teaching Strategies, The Creative Curriculum for Preschool as our curriculum of choice. Several of the 38 objectives for development and learning are associated with literacy. Preschooler's literacy skills vary greatly in their abilities, and our teachers continue to provide the developmentally appropriate academics by challenging children and providing the achievable literacy experiences for each child. Literacy should be a source of enjoyment and for preschoolers connected to real life reasons to use their skills. Remember there are many phases of children's writing that include letter like forms in scribble drawings to writing and drawing letters that begin to spell words.

### **A MESSAGE FROM THE STEWARDSHIP & FINANCE COMMITTEE...**

Dear Church Family,

We are rapidly closing in on year-end, a special and happy time of year in our worship life.

**Stewardship Campaign Update** – Dedication Sunday was on October 22. Thank you again for renewing your support for 2018. Session will be working hard over the next couple months putting together a 2018 budget. Your faithful financial support is a necessary and important part of this process.

**On-line Giving** – The new church website now has an on-line giving feature. By clicking on “Give” at the bottom of the Home page, you can set up one-time or recurring gifts via credit or debit card to support our operating budget, special offerings or dedicated gifts.

**Gifts of Appreciated Securities** – Gifts of stocks or shares of mutual funds are often a tax efficient means for gifting. Please refer to instructions in the “Give” section of our website for how to arrange the transfer of securities from your brokerage account to the church.

**2017 Budget Update** - As is sometimes the case in a dynamic organization such as our church, our ambitions can temporarily stretch our financial resources. Through a combination of higher than expected expenses and lower than expected income, through the end of November our operating budget has incurred a larger than anticipated deficit in excess of \$85,000. While we are fortunate to have an endowment fund that we can use to cover operating deficits such as this, our goal is to fund our operating needs with current offerings. If possible, please consider a year-end gift to help reduce our current year budget deficit.

**Pledge Update** – The 11-month statement of gifts we have received was mailed to everyone recently. Please review this for accuracy and contact me with any questions or adjustments. The full year pledge statement will be sent to you in January 2018. Giving envelopes for 2018 are available for you to pick up in Fellowship Hall.

We are an active church. The work of our Church is on-going and is only made possible through your faithful and generous contributions.
