As you know the Cranbury Presbyterian Nursery School is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) and this year is a renewal year. Our renewal materials have been sent and our teachers continue to work providing the evidence to share with the NAEYC assessors showing the amazing things that happens at CPNS every day. For those of you that are not familiar with NAEYC, they are the nation's largest organization of early childhood educators. To obtain this accreditation, CPNS has voluntarily undergone a comprehensive process of internal self-study and continuous improvements to provide the highest quality Christian preschool program.

Research shows a direct correlation between high-quality early learning and children's positive long-term outcomes in life, including increased educational attainment, healthier lifestyles, and more successful careers. NAEYC Accreditation helps teachers and other staff at early learning programs; such as CPNS, develop a shared understanding and commitment to quality. The accreditation process leads to increased staff morale, greater staff retention, and a more positive, energetic work atmosphere overall—enabling preschools to provide a solid foundation for all children's success in life.

We continue to register for the 2018-2019 school year. We have openings in some of our classes and enrichment programs, so there is still time.
